About the project

The Hatchling is a spectacular large-scale, live event set to be performed in Wakefield as part of the districts Our Year celebration. Centred around the story of an incredible dragon puppet, The Hatchling is a breath taking outdoor theatrical performance created by a world class team of experts in design, kite flying and puppeteering, which will unfold over the August bank holiday weekend (Fri 23rd – Sun 25th Aug 2024). This visit will mark The Hatchling's third ever outing and its second ever flight, having made its world premiere in Plymouth in 2021.

The creative team include puppet director of War Horse, Mervyn Millar, a kite world champion flier and set designer for Bjork, Carl Robertshaw, award-winning Artistic Director Angie Bual and producers, Trigger.



A large-scale free theatrical experience across one weekend, this project fuses myth, legend, science, puppetry & aerodynamics into one unforgettable event, which will use the city centre of Wakefield and Pugneys as a stage. The final event is on 23-25th August 2024 and will have extensive local and national press coverage (radio and broadcast).
